The 509 Task Forces is currently conducting mobile security at the border of Indonesia and Papua New Guinea, especially in the region of Intan Jaya Regency. On Saturday, 10 August 2024, the 509 Task Forces held a Territorial Activity entitled "Free Health Treatment" for residents of Bilogai Village, Sugapa District. This activity helped the residents with difficulties in the health sector, one of the community's basic needs.

On Saturday, during its routine task, the Bilogai Post led by First Lieutenant Abdian, had their Medical Team conducted free Health Treatment for the community.
